## Group Aliyah -

## An engine for growth and strengthening the south and north of Israel

An innovative move to encourage Aliyah, strengthen the periphery, and build prosperous communities

- The "Iron Swords" War created an immediate need and critical national task to restore and strengthen the Negev and Galilee regions
- Aliyah contributes to strengthening the country's demographic, security and economic stability
- Group Aliyah is a model forming organized groups of Olim who come on Aliyah together to a local authority
- Families will live near each other and receive a tailored basket of services together





#### **Rationale and Basic Principles**

Group Aliyah model supports demographic, economic and community growth and strengthens Israeli-World Jewish connections

- Growth: Strengthening the affected areas and creating demographic and national stability
- Strengthening communities: Local cohesion and connection with long-time residents
- Mutual support: Group Aliyah enables faster integration
- Economic growth engines: Strengthening the local economy and developing the periphery
- Solidarity: Strengthening their feeling of belonging to Israeli society
